FURTHER EVENT INFORMATION

Power Plant is an outdoor event and is experienced by following lit pathways through bush trails and across an open field. Your journey begins in the event entrance area on the corner of The Crescent and Kiosk Road, next to the Wintergarden Pavilion Café and duck ponds. Once you are there, join the short queue that corresponds with your session time.

Power Plant will go ahead rain or shine. There is no rain shelter on site so we suggest that you bring a raincoat. Please remember to wear comfortable walking shoes (or Gumboots) with good grip, as there are hills and steps and the walk is mostly in the bush.

The track is not suitable for wheelchairs, buggies or strollers.

Entry Times

We suggest arriving 20 minutes earlier than the time on your ticket to give you time to find your queue. On arrival to the site, find the queue for your session time stipulated on your ticket. One of our friendly ushers will brief you and lead you to the beginning of the event pathway. Once you are in, follow the pathway in one direction. The route is approximately 1.2km long. The event closes at approximately 11.00pm.

Wheelchair Accessibility

Sorry, there is no wheelchair access to this event. There are no accessible pick up or drop off points at the Domain.

Getting to the Domain and Parking

We encourage you to use public transport to travel to the event site, which is within easy walking distance via Park Road, Lower Domain Drive and Domain Drive. There will be road closures in place and car parking adjacent to the Domain is limited. The closest train stations are Grafton Station and Newmarket Station. There are INNER LINK bus stops along Park Road, Parnell Road and Broadway and also OUTER LINK bus stops on Parnell Rd and Broadway. There is a Wilson car park at Carlaw Park Ave and other carparks as indicated on the venue map.

If you need to bring a car, look for the low cost carparks in Wilson parking buildings in Newmarket (discounted prices after 6pm).

Ticket Sales

Tickets can be purchased online and from the Ticketmaster box office on show days from 7.00pm, subject to availability. Gate sales are \$35 for adults, \$32 for concession card holders, \$15 for children 14 and under and FREE for children 4 and under. All ticket sales are subject to availability. EFTPOS is available at the on-site box office for ticket purchases.

Ticket pick ups

Tickets can be collected from the Ticketmaster box office at the main gate from 7.00pm onwards.

Pass outs

There are no pass-outs from the event.

Alcohol

This is not a licensed event and there is no alcohol for sale on site. BYO is not permitted. Bag searches may be conducted at the gate. The Festival reserves the right to remove intoxicated people from the show site.

Animals

Other than Guide Dogs and other support dogs, animals are not permitted at the event.

Toilets

Portable toilets are available on site.

Food and non-alcoholic drinks

There will be Mojo coffee and Kapiti icecream available onsite. Please do not bring picnics or meals into the event, as there are limited places to stop along the route. It will be best to travel light.

EFTPOS

There are no cash out facilities on site. Some vendors may offer EFTPOS but this is not guaranteed. Please bring CASH.

Conditions of Entry

Conditions of Entry for safety and comfort, the following items are prohibited inside the gate: Seating of any kind, Musical instruments or air horns, poles, sticks, banners or oversized flags (more than 1m x 1m), Weapons or knives, or any object which may be used as a weapon or missile, animals (exceptions for authorised guide/companion dogs), balls, sporting equipment, bicycles, skateboards, skates or scooters. Tents, picnic hampers, laser lights or any other item the event organisers considers inappropriate.
